## In-Class Lab 4 –


1. Run the Contacts app
2. Add a few people to the list, include their phone number
3. Select a contact, click on the call button: 
4. Talk to the person, then end the call
5. Pair up with a “class buddy”
6. Enter each other’s contact info in your contacts list
7. Using the Phone app, call each other by selecting their contact and pressing the call button: 
8. More advanced: Take a photo of your class-buddy, edit and update contact.
9. Have your class-buddy call you, do you see their photo?

10. Using the Message app, send a text message to your class-buddy
11. See the Message notification: 
12. Run the Message app, see the message in the list
13. Click on the message to read it.
14. Enter a reply to the message, send it.
15. Repeat sending messages back and forth until it gets comfortable.
16. Attach photos to messages, send to each other.
17. View the message and attachment.
18. Open a message by clicking on a notification.
19. Return a call by clicking on a notification
20. Clear the notifications.
21. Send a text message to your class-buddy by clicking on the message icon in their contact listing: 

## 22. Advanced topic – Browsing

- Open your browser (Internet, Chrome, other)
- Enter the web location [www.google.com](http://www.google.com) in the address line, press “Go”
- Use google to search for a desired term or phrase, click on a link
- Once you arrive at the desired site, spread or pinch to enlarge or shrink the image
- Click around, go to different sites

## 23. Advanced topic: Gmail

- Run the Gmail app 
- You should see a list of emails you've already received. If you need help, ask!
- Click on a message to view
- Click the back button to go back to list, repeat
